<p>30 Questions that consist of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Two (2) Constructed Response</i> • <i>1 “Evidence-based” Question (this could be a primary source, graphic, picture, etc)</i> • <i>No more than FIVE (5) “True / False” Questions</i> • <i>No more than TEN (10) “Matching” Questions</i> • <i>No more than FIVE (5) “Fill-In-The-Blank” Questions</i> • <i>The remainder should be “Multiple Choice”</i> <p>Questions should be DIRECTLY tied to the Learning Standards</p> <p>Multiple-Choice questions should include ONE (1) correct choice and three (3) “distractor” choices that are reasonable and make sense for the question</p> <p>You MAY include a “Word Bank” for the Fill-In-The-Blank Questions. If you choose to do this, there should be MORE words than questions</p> <p>For “Matching” -type questions, the description or definition should be in LEFT column and the answer choices should be in the RIGHT column</p>	<p>20 POINTS</p>		
<p>Answer Key with CORRECT ANSWERS for ALL questions</p>	<p>5 POINTS</p>		
<p>50% of your questions should be “Level I” -type questions 50% of your questions should be “Level II & Level III” -type questions (Questions should be marked with a L1, L2, or L3)</p>	<p>10 POINTS</p>
